### Priscilla Programme 2020-21

#### Programme Costs

The price of each module of the Priscilla Programme is £250. This covers the cost of your online enrolment, all online training, weekly seminars whether online or in an approved local seminar group, downloadable worksheets, access to the online forum and individual tutorials. There is no application fee to pay.

The course comprises 6 modules, and so the total course will cost £1500. Although we recommend that you consider studying all 6 modules, by enrolling for a module you are not committed to studying for the whole course. You will enrol for each module separately and you can take as many or as few modules as you choose. You can work through the whole course in two years, or you can take breaks between modules.

To reflect ongoing cost changes, it might be necessary to increase the price of modules in future years.

### Payment of Course Costs

Once you have been accepted onto the course for your first module, you will be registered as a Priscilla student. You will then be asked to pay for the module/s you have selected, in advance of the course start date.

Payments are made online by debit or credit card.

### Cancellations, withdrawals and refunds

After you have been accepted onto the course but before you are given online access to the course (the start of the course) you have 14 days in which to change your mind and cancel your registration. You will receive a full refund of any course costs you have paid.

Once you have been given online access to the course (the start of the course), should you be unable or decide not to continue your studies, we regret that no refunds or credits will be given, except where the reason for your withdrawal is due to exceptional circumstances. Exceptional circumstances include, but are not limited to, serious illness or bereavement. The decision whether or not to grant a refund or credit will be made by the Course Leader.

If for any reason we are unable to run any of the modules for which you have registered and paid, we will refund your payment or offer you a credit towards a future module.

### Discounts

If you are studying with a local seminar group of at least 5 students, which has been approved by Union/ Church Society, you will be entitled to a discount of 20% off the cost of each module.

If you are the wife of a current registered student of Union School of Theology, you will be entitled to a discount of 20% off the cost of each module.
